


Discipleship Pathway Assessment – Seeking God

National Survey of Protestant
Churchgoers


Methodology

- The online survey of 2,500 Protestant churchgoers was conducted January 14–29, 2019 using a national pre-recruited panel
- Respondents were screened to include those who identified as Protestant/non-denominational and attend religious services at least once a month
- Quotas and slight weights were used to balance gender, age, region, ethnicity, income, and denominational affiliation
- The completed sample is 2,500 surveys
- The sample provides 95% confidence that the sampling error from the panel does not exceed $\pm 2.0\%$
- Margins of error are higher in sub-groups


Survey Responses




“Throughout many of my activities I don’t think about God”

Significant Statistical Differences

Comparisons were made to determine if there are any significant statistical differences among gender, region, age, and ethnicity.

Note: Region is defined by US Census locations

Significant Statistical Differences

Comparisons were made to determine if there are any significant statistical differences among education, worship service attendance, and religious tradition.

Education	Worship Service Attendance	Religious Tradition
High School graduate or less	Once a week or more	Evangelical Protestant
Some college	Once or twice a month	Black Protestant
Bachelor's Degree	A few times a year	Mainline Protestant
Graduate Degree	Once a year or less	
Education	Never	

“Throughout many of my activities I don’t think about God”

- Females are more likely to Strongly Disagree than Males (45% v. 33%)
- Those in the Northeast (41%) and South (43%) are more likely to Strongly Disagree than those in the Midwest (31%)
- Those age 35-49 (42%) and 50-64 (46%) are more likely to Strongly Disagree than those age 18-34 (33%) and 65+ (36%)
- African Americans (55%) and Hispanics (51%) are more likely to Strongly Disagree than Whites (33%) and Other Ethnicities (32%)
- Those who are High School Graduates or less (46%) are more likely to Strongly Disagree than those with a Bachelor’s Degree (35%) or a Graduate Degree (35%)
- Those who attend a worship service four times a month or more are more likely to Strongly Disagree than those who attend less than 4 times a month (41% v. 36%)
- Black Protestants (58%) are more likely to Strongly Disagree than Evangelical Protestants (40%) and Mainline Protestants (27%)

“Set aside time for private worship, praise, or thanksgiving to God”

- Females are more likely to answer “Every Day” than Males (40% v. 36%)
- Those in the South (41%) are more likely to answer “Every Day” Agree than those in the Midwest (35%)
- Those 50-64 (45%) are more likely to answer “Every Day” than those age 18-34 (32%) and 35-49 (36%)
- African Americans (45%) and Hispanics (43%) are more likely to answer “Every Day” than Whites (36%) and Other Ethnicities (31%)
- Those who are High School Graduates or less (41%) or with Some College (41%) are more likely to answer “Every Day” than those with a Bachelor’s Degree (35%) or a Graduate Degree (34%)
- Those who attend a worship service four times a month or more are more likely to answer “Every Day” than those who attend less than 4 times a month (40% v. 33%)
- Evangelical Protestants (40%) and Black Protestants (46%) are more likely to answer “Every Day” than Mainline Protestants (29%)

- Females are more likely to Strongly Agree than Males (49% v. 36%)
- Those in the South (45%) and West (46%) are more likely to Strongly Agree than those in the Northeast (37%)
- Those 50-64 are the most likely to Strongly Agree (50%), while those age 18-34 are least likely (36%)
- Those who are High School Graduates or less (47%) or with Some College (46%) are more likely to Strongly Agree than those with a Graduate Degree (36%)
- Those who attend a worship service four times a month or more are more likely to Strongly Agree than those who attend less than 4 times a month (46% v. 38%)
- Evangelical Protestants (46%) and Black Protestants (45%) are more likely to Strongly Agree than Mainline Protestants (32%)
